In addition to Aquapark, Käyrälampi is home to Tykkimäki Resort and other services in the area. You won't be able to see everything in one day, so make sure you are prepared to spend the entire weekend.

Peace of the forest

Located right along road-6, **Arboretum Mustila** is a great place to relax in the forest and admire a wide variety of plants and flowers. The 120 hectare area welcomes visitors with hundreds of different species of plants from all over the world. Mustila is familiar to many for its flowers, but it is a major tree species park in Finland, with Douglas spruce trees reaching 40 metres in height!

All of Mustila's rhododendrons do not bloom at exact same time. The main bloom of the azaleas and the first wave of the rhododendrons often occurs in June. However, it is worth remembering that there is much more to see in the arboretum than just rhododendrons and azaleas. Once the rhododendrons have finished blooming, the arboretum's hydrangeas, which are quite impressive, will each take their turn to bloom until the end of summer.

The Mustila area is also home to **Mustila Viini**, where you can find award-winning wines and a variety of local produce and delicacies. In the atmospheric shop, you can enjoy drinks by the glass and food services by pre-order. Mustila Viini also offers a range of service packages, perfect for relaxing with your friend group of colleagues.



The autumn colours are at their most colourful in Mustila from late September to mid-October, when many native and exotic trees turn to different beautiful autumn colours. Even in mid- and late October, you can still admire the brown of oaks, beech and larch trees, as well as the distinctive autumn colours of the witch hazel. You can also enjoy the peace of the forest on Kouvola's different nature trails such as Niivermäki, Heisanharju and the Kymijoki River outdoor trail.



A World Heritage Site and a National Park

Not every city has a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a National Park, but in Kouvola you can find both!

Repovesi National Park needs no further introduction, and its postcard landscapes have graced many social media posts and travel brochures over the years. In addition to the lush forest landscapes, you can also admire the majestic cliffs of Repovesi. In addition to hiking in the forest trails, you can admire the National Park's scenery from above the treetops, for example from the observation tower of Mustalamminvuori or from Olhava. The brave and the bold have made Olhava their own and the cliffs are a well-known climbing destination.

Repovesi is a magnificent natural destination all year round, and the various services offered by the national park allow you to explore the area by mountain bike or canoe. In addition to the Lapinsalmi car park, you can also start your hike from Saarijärvi or Tervajärvi.



UNESCO World Heritage Site of Verla is a unique and magnificent site on the UNESCO World Heritage List. History comes alive on the museum's guided tours, and the setting of Verla is also a great place to enjoy the region's many activities and attractions. Authentic and idyllic, Verla is the only forest industry site on the World Heritage List and is a striking combination of nature, history and culture. This museum site will really charm the whole family!



Theatre, concerts or exhibitions?

Kouvola offers a wide range of cultural activities, whether you're looking for theatre, concerts, exhibitions or industrial history.

Ankkapurha Cultural Park on the banks of the Kymijoki River is a hub of history, culture and activities. In addition to the Ankkapurha Youth Centre, you can explore the valuable and impressive factory heritage of the Kymenlaakso region and the residential area designed by the world-famous Alvar Aalto. But will you find out during your visit what the word "Ankkapurha" means?

Taideruukki, located near the old factory complex in Kuusankoski, is known for Pato Klubi, art galleries,

craftsmen's workshops and small boutiques. The building is a maze, which is an essential part of the historic building's personality. Pato Klubi hosts exhibitions and various cultural events. Finland's most important artists perform in large numbers in a unique concert hall. You will also find a cosy café with a variety of delicacies in Taideruukki.

Great emotions from all sides and great guest stars known to the whole nation. **Kouvola Theatre** is a great place to visit with a group of friends, but an evening in the theatre is also a wonderful way to enjoy Finnish culture.



You'll find thought-provoking works and great art in the **Poikilo-museums'** changing exhibitions. In addition to the art museum, Poikilo also houses a city museum, which sheds light on Kouvola's interesting urban history. All this under one roof, right in the centre of Kouvola.
